You are a British national?

As a British national you need:

- a valid identity card or
- a valid passport

AND

- documents to show why you want to continue living in Austria.

Depending on what you marked under Point C you will need the following documents.

You marked (27) **Arbeitnehmer** (worker)? Then you will also need:

- a work contract or
- a confirmation of engagement from the employer.

You marked (28) **selbständige erwerbstätig** (self-employed)? Then you will also need:

proof that you are self-employed.

For example: a work contract, fee notes, your income tax assessment for the last year.

You marked (29) **Privatier/ nicht erwerbstätige Person** (economically inactive person)? Then you will also need:

- proof that you have comprehensive sickness insurance cover in Austria
- proof that you have sufficient resources for yourself and your family members for your planned stay in Austria.

You can show sufficient resources through your income or savings. For example your pension.

You marked (30) **Schüler /Studierender (Ausbildung)** (pupil/student [in education])? Then you will also need:

- proof of enrolment at an establishment accredited or financed by Austria
- proof that you have comprehensive sickness insurance cover in Austria
- proof that you have sufficient resources for yourself and your family members for your planned stay in Austria.

As husband, wife or registered partner you also need:

- your Anmeldebescheinigung (registration certificate) as a family member
- OR
- a wedding certificate or certificate on your registered partnership.
